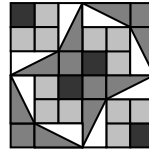


March block of the month FLUTTERBYE

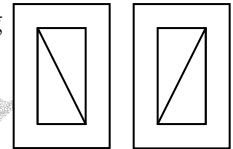


This month the block will be made with the three primary colours plus a white background. It looks complicated but is not. Read all the directions before proceeding.

You will need to cut: - red - blue -yellow

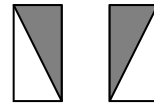
From the three primary colours cut 4 each 2 1/2 "squares  
From yellow cut 4 - 2 1/2 " X 4 1/2 " rectangles

In order to get the sharpest points you will need to foundation piece the following sections.



Draw eight 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" rectangles on foundation paper. Within each of these rectangles draw another rectangle 2" X 4". This will show you where the seam allowance is. Draw a diagonal line within the smaller triangle from point to point. You can carry it on through to the edge of the paper but please note that it WILL NOT match the outer points. You will need 4 of each rectangle, 8 rectangles in total.

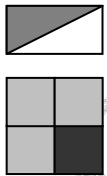
Sew these rectangles with blue and white. You should have 4 of each direction, eight in total.



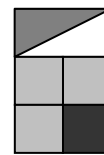
Sew the yellow squares to the red squares, press toward the red square.



Sew the 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" yellow rectangle to the red and yellow rectangle. Press towards the yellow rectangle.



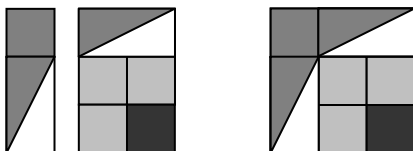
Take the 4 foundation pieced rectangles that look like this and sew them to the yellow and red square you just finished. Make sure the white part of this unit is sewn to the yellow rectangle.



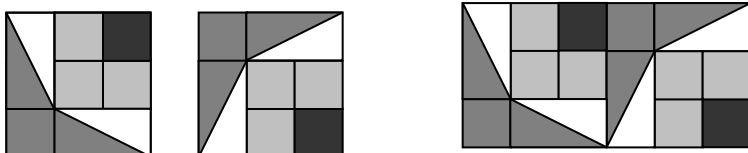
Sew the blue squares to the to the other blue and white foundation pieced rectangles.

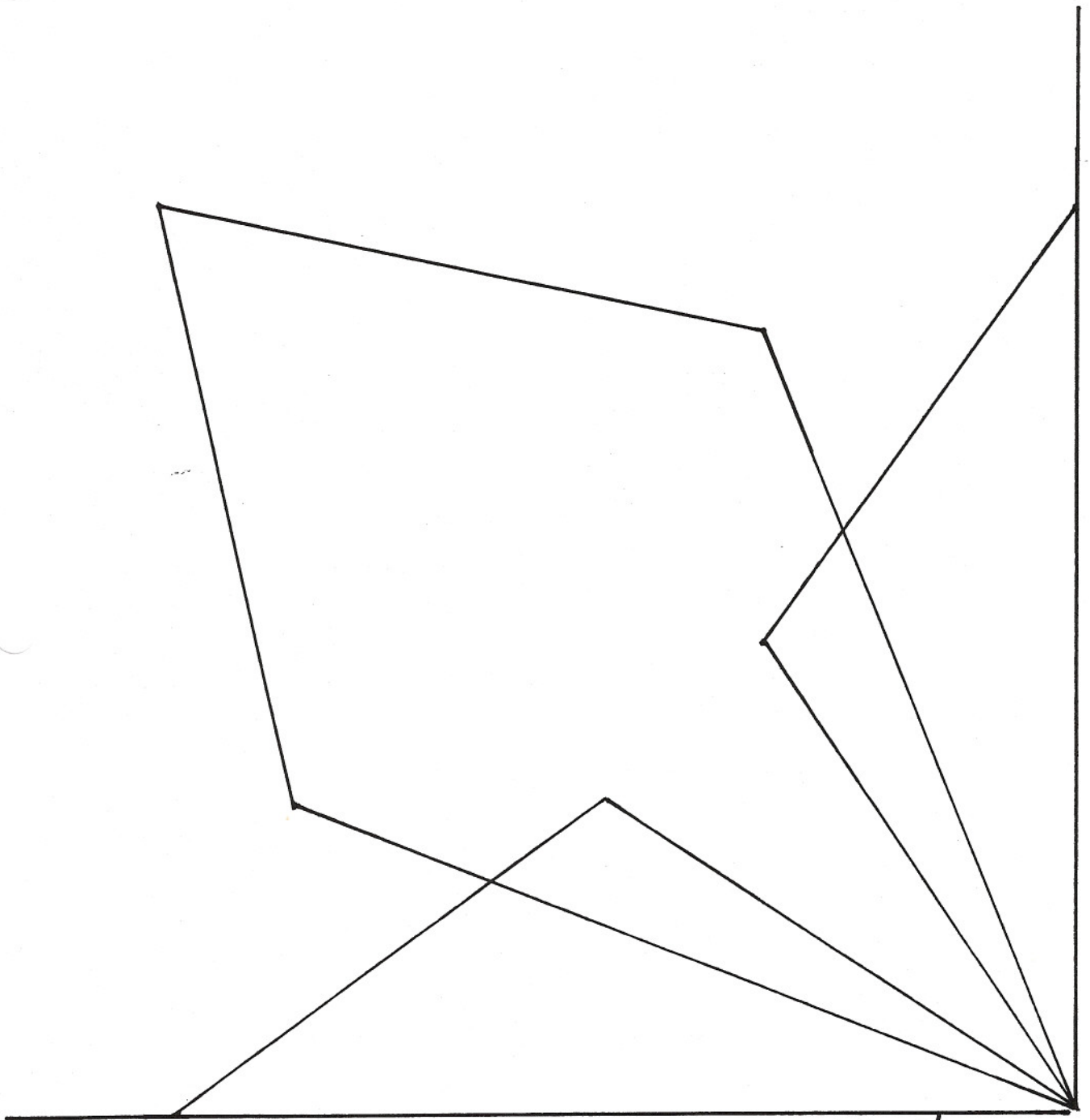


Sew this rectangle to the last unit like this:



You can now assemble the block. Refer to the block graphic at the top of the page.
