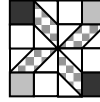


May block of the month: Clay's Choice with a twist



This month will be a monochromatic theme; white background and blues.

Cut 12 – 3 1/2" squares of white

Cut 2 – 3 1/2" squares of dark blue

Cut 2 – 3 1/2" squares of light blue

Cut 4 – 3 1/2" X 6 1/2" rectangles of a medium blue PRINT.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 8 of the white squares.

Sew the 2 dark blue squares to 2 white squares.

Sew the 2 light blue squares to 2 white squares.

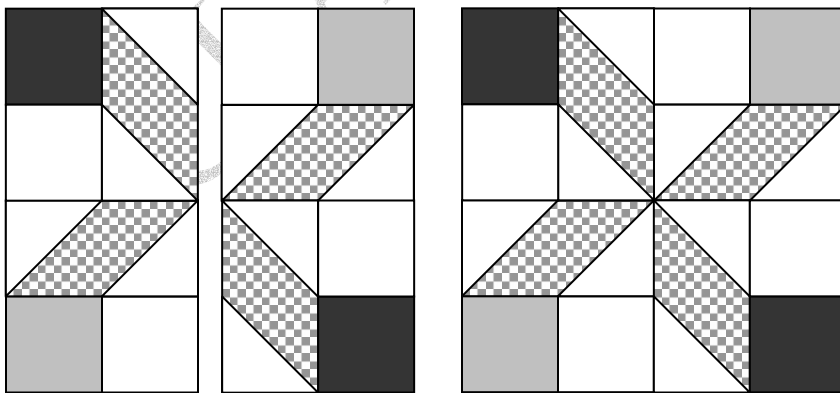
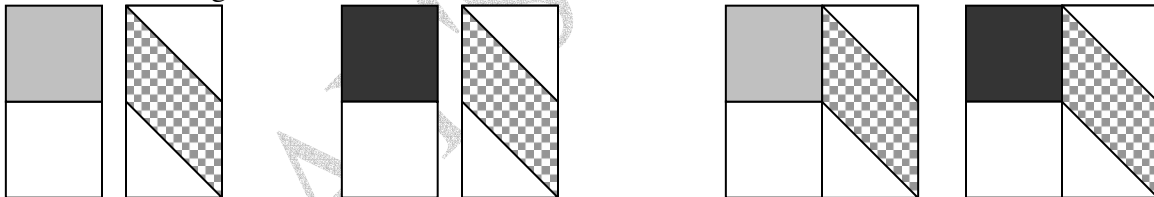


Place the white squares with diagonal lines on the rectangles. Sew along the marked line. Cut away the extra a 1/4" from the seam line press toward the white triangle.

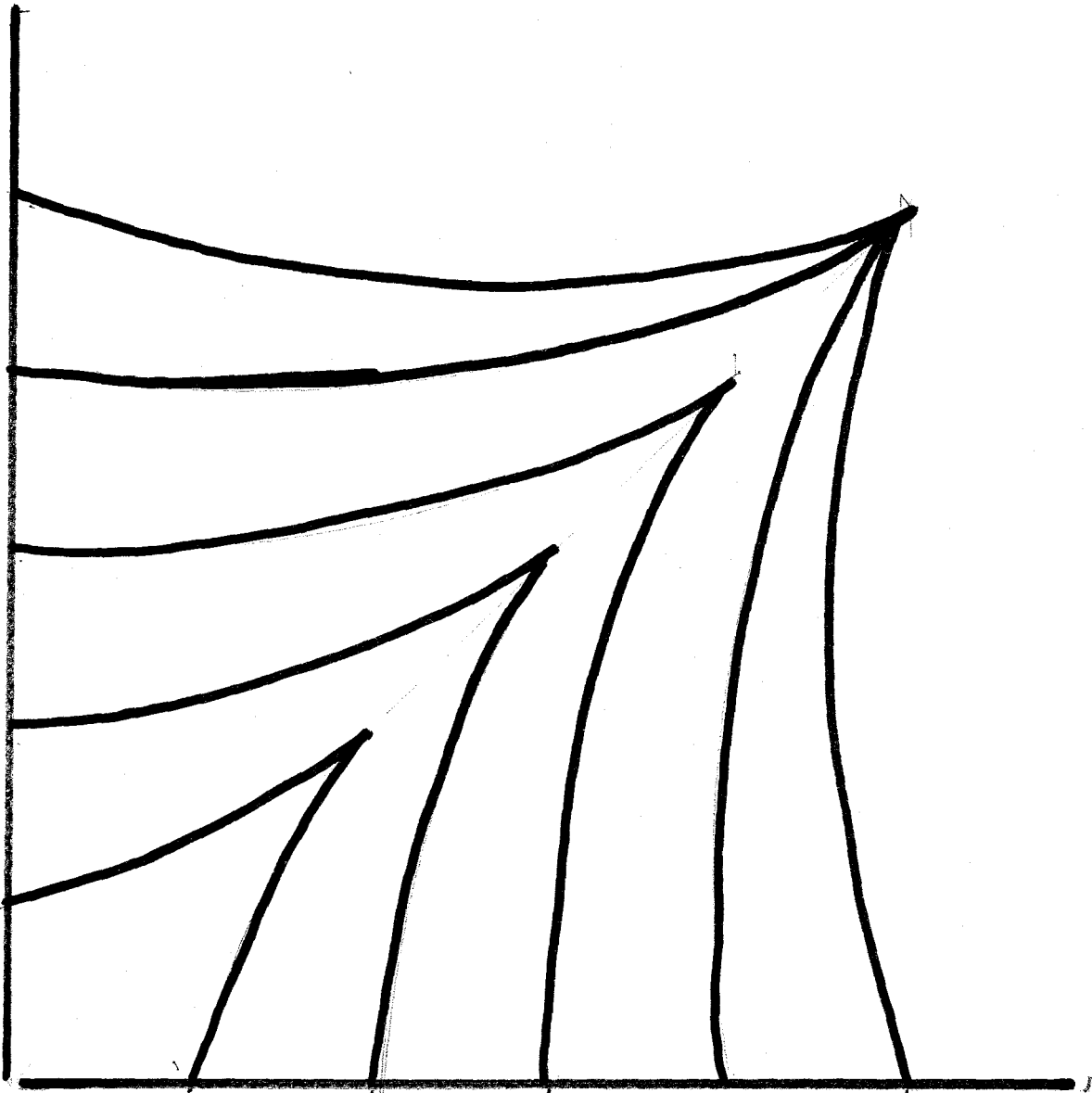


Repeat for the other side. Make sure your parallelograms all go in the same direction.

Sew the units together.



The addition of a four patch is created in the overall appearance by changing just one element of this block, creating a secondary design.
