

Card Trick October block of the month

In keeping with the rainbow we are going to go around the colour wheel. Since most of us do not have either orange or many yellows we will adjust the gray scale for this month and use gold and rust as our mediums with a neutral background.

For exchange the background will be unbleached muslin. For those of you who will also be making your own quilt keep with either your white or dark background.

To keep things simple all references to the background colour will apply to the neutral fabric colour.

Cut

Background 2 – 4 7/8 squares, cut again on the diagonal for 4 – HST

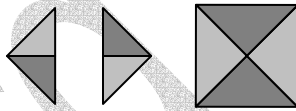
1 – 5 1/4 square, cut twice on the diagonal for 4 – QST

Gold and rust 2 each– 4 7/8 squares, cut again on the diagonal for 4 – HST of each color.

1 each – 5 1/4 square, cut twice on the diagonal for 4 – QST

Sew

Take 2 each of the gold and rust QST triangles, sew together, pressing towards the darker triangle. Then sew the new triangles together to make a square.



Sew the remaining 2 gold and 2 rust QST triangles to the 4 background QST triangles.



Sew the background HST triangles to the gold and rust HST triangles. You should have 4 HST squares, 2 of each colour.



Sew :

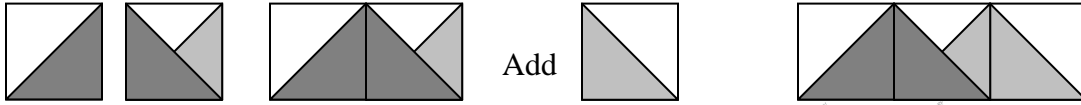
This part may seem confusing but if you sew the two smaller triangles (gold + background and rust + background) together with the third colour HST triangle it will all turn out. Just remember that there should be three different colours in this 4” square.

Make two of each.

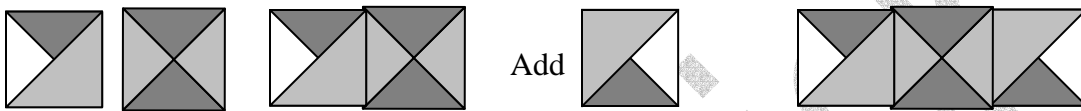


Sewing the card trick units together.

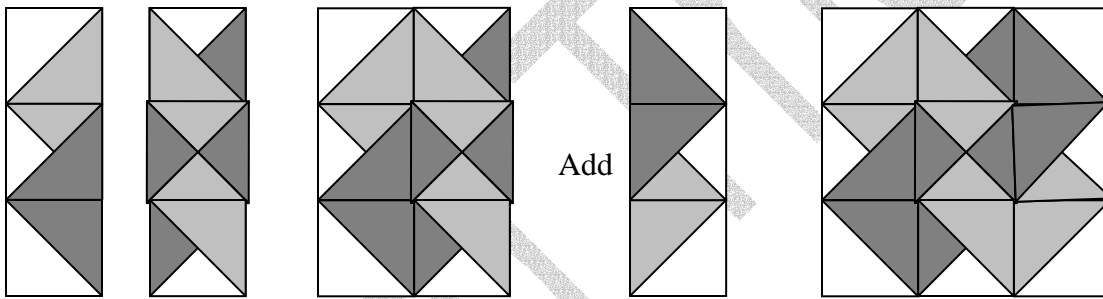
Make two of these:
